How long we will keep your data for:

This is in line with BCC's Consultation and Engagement Storage Protocol and will be monitored by the City Council service commissioning this survey.

Why we need to collect your data:

Who we share your data with and why:

This data will be disclosed to BCC Consultation and engagement team and the team commissioning this survey as required.

If we have obtained your consent to use your data:

You are freely able to withdraw your consent for us to process your information at any given time.
