 Wychavon recycles

All homes in Worcestershire have the same recycling service. This table lists all the materials that can be recycled through your kerbside collection and at EnviroSort, the recycling plant.

Make sure your recycling is clean – a quick rinse under the tap to remove any residue will do. Make sure your recycling is loose – please don't put it in a plastic bag.



Household metal packaging

- ✓ Food tins
- ✓ Pet food tins
- ✓ Drinks cans
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Sweet and biscuit tins
- ✓ Metal lids from jars and bottles

TIP: Labels can be left on

Food and drinks cans only

No other types of metals e.g.

saucepans, cutlery, tools etc

Please don't flatten cans

Push sharp lids into cans

Separate plastic lids off aerosols and

put them in your recycling bin loose

No foil - this can be taken to your nearest Household Recycling Centre

No foil pouches or sweet

wrappers - these need to go in your black/grey bin.

No coffee pods or crisp

Packets - these can be taken to your nearest recycling point

No gas bottles

Household plastic packaging

- ✓ Soft drinks bottles Milk/ juice cartons
- ✓ Detergent/fabric conditioner bottles
- ✓ Cleaning spray bottles
- ✓ Bleach bottles
- ✓ Shampoo and conditioner bottles
- ✓ Shower gel bottles
- ✓ Margarine tubs
- ✓ Ice cream tubs
- ✓ Yoghurt pots
- ✓ Cream
- ✓ Jelly
- ✓ Custard pots
- ✓ Fruit punnets
- ✓ Meat trays
- ✓ Ready meal trays
- ✓ Cake trays
- ✓ Egg boxes

TIP: Think bottle, tub, pot, tray

No black plastic

Please wash out where possible

Don't flatten plastic packaging

Bottle tops can be included - just

screw the lid back onto the bottle after you've cleaned it

No pump tops no film, foil etc

No plastic bags

No crisp wrappers or sweet wrappers

No plant pots

No hard plastics

e.g. children's toys, garden containers, bins, water butts etc

Mixed glass bottles and jars

- ✓ Glass food and drinks bottles
- ✓ Glass food and drinks jars
- ✓ Make up jars
- ✓ Fragrance bottles
- ✓ Moisturiser jars

TIPS:

No need to remove labels
Lids can be left on
All colours of glass are accepted

Glass bottles and jars only
No drinking glasses, pyrex, window glass etc
No nail varnish bottles
Make sure all items are clean

Mixed paper

- ✓ Newspaper and magazines
- ✓ Catalogues/brochures
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Phonebooks
- ✓ Junk mail/leaflets
- ✓ Greetings cards
- ✓ Letters

Keep paper flat
Remove any plastic wrappers
No glittery cards or wrapping paper

No metallic/film coated wrapping paper
No dirty/stained paper
No sticky paper e.g labels

Cardboard

- ✓ Cardboard packing
- ✓ Egg boxes
- ✓ Toilet roll tubes
- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Toothpaste boxes
- ✓ Dishwater tablet boxes
- ✓ Ready meal card sleeves
- ✓ Kitchen roll tubes
- ✓ Pet food boxes

Flatten cardboard boxes and tubes
No contaminated Packaging e.g. food waste in takeaway pizza boxes

Remove inner packaging - film, bags and polystyrene need to go into your black/grey bin

Cartons

- ✓ Milk/juice/smoothies
- ✓ Fabric conditioner
- ✓ UHT milk
- ✓ Soup/passata
- ✓ Custard

TIP: plastic spouts can be left on
Please flatten cartons

Remove lids-these can be put into your recycling bin separately
