## ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014 SECTION 59

## BRISTOL CITY COUNCIL (DOGS EXCLUSION) (SOUTH STREET PLAYING FIELDS, BEDMINSTER) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2020

BRISTOL CITY COUNCIL (the Council) in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act) makes the following Order in respect of South Street Playing Fields, Bedminster, Bristol (the Restricted Area): -

- 1. The Council is satisfied that the conditions set out in section 59 of the Act have been met, including that the anti-social behaviour arising from people who fail to clean up after their dogs and where dogs are not properly supervised and kept under control in the Restricted Area, has had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality.
- 2. This Order applies to the Restricted Area delineated by a dashed red line on the map annexed to this Order.
- 3. Dogs are NOT permitted to enter or remain in the Restricted Area. This prohibition applies at all times.
- 4. Any person who without reasonable excuse fails to comply with the prohibition in this Order commits an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- 5. A Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued to a person who a constable or authorised person has reason to believe has committed an offence in relation to this Order, offering the person to whom it is issued the opportunity of discharging any liability to conviction for the offence by payment of a fixed penalty.

## 6. Exemptions for Disabled Persons

The provisions in this Order do not apply to the following persons:

- a. Partially sighted or sight impaired
- b. Those with a disability affecting mobility
- 7. The Dog Exclusion provisions in this Order do not apply to a dog trained by a registered charity to assist a person with a disability and upon which a disabled person relies for assistance.

- 8. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date on which this Order is made.
- 9. This Order shall come into operation on the date it is made and shall remain in place for a period of three years.
